Submission Process:

Submissions should be original, unpublished, and not under consideration for publication elsewhere. Interested authors should submit their full papers directly to the Ocean Engineering and select the special issue "[Special Issue of ITTC](#)". Full papers will be published online-first on a rolling basis soon after acceptance. The journal offers full open access for submissions selected to the special issue with Article Publishing Charge (APC), but there will be no processing fee if open access is not chosen.
